The Foundry is a remarkable RIBA Award winning building located in Vauxhall, Central London. As a vibrant Centre for social justice and human rights organisations, it is the result of a unique partnership between Trust for London, Joseph Rowntree Charitable Trust, The Barrow Cadbury Trust, LankellyChase Foundation and The Ethical Property Company.

This beautifully renovated former factory includes 2,900m<sup>2</sup> of office space and is home to 30 social change and human rights-focused organisations working in modern, secure surroundings.

The Foundry also offers state of the art meeting spaces and facilities, ideal for hosting conferences, events, seminars and exhibitions, all in a central location. Meeting space in the Centre is available both to voluntary and private sector organisations, with discounted rates available to registered charities, CIC's and social enterprises.

## Managed by Ethical Property


The Centre is managed by The Ethical Property Company, a Living Wage employer who own and/or manage further centres across the UK to high environmental standards.

# Conference and meeting space

The Foundry contains seven meeting rooms of different sizes with a range of the latest built-in audio-visual equipment. Seating options are flexible and can be adapted to meet your specific requirements.

The Foundry's ground floor Conference Hall can host events for up to 90 delegates (in a theatre layout) and is located adjacent to the atrium. The Centre's six meeting rooms include a variety of spaces for between 10 and 80 delegates. The top floor meeting spaces, when combined, are capable of hosting a total of 110 delegates (in a theatre layout).

Across all meeting spaces The Foundry can accommodate events for up to 275 people (depending on the room layouts).

The Centre provides the ideal environment for conferences, AGMs, informal meetings, training and interviews.

Directions

By London Underground

There are two underground stations within short walking distance from The Foundry - Oval and Vauxhall

When exiting Oval Station, turn left onto Harleyford St. As you reach The Oval Cricket Ground, turn right onto Kennington Oval. Walk anti-clockwise around the Oval ground for approx. 400m, past Vauxhall St until you see 'Grace House' and turn right onto the public footpath that leads to Oval Way

From Vauxhall Station walk down Kennington Lane for approx. 350m Oval Way is on the right. By bus

Routes 2, 36, 77, 87, 88, 156, 185, 196, 344, 360, 436 and Night Routes N2, N87 and N136 serve Vauxhall bus station which is a short walk from The Foundry.
