What is coronavirus?

A coronavirus is a type of virus which is common across the world. Typical symptoms include fever and a cough that may progress to a severe pneumonia causing shortness of breath and breathing difficulties.

Generally, coronavirus can cause more severe symptoms in people with weakened immune systems, older people, and those with long-term conditions like diabetes, cancer and chronic lung disease.

Covid-19 is a new strain of coronavirus first identified in Wuhan City, China. On 30 January 2020, the World Health Organisation declared a public health emergency of international concern, and UK Chief Medical Officers have raised the risk to the public from low to moderate. However, the risk to individuals remains low. Information, including the number of UK cases, is being updated daily on the Government website. Please check regularly for changes.

Do I need to take any precautionary measures?

At this time of year, viral respiratory infections such as colds and influenza are very common in the community within the UK, and if your team and delegates develop viral symptoms they should manage these as they usually would.

The recommended steps people should take to protect themselves are the same as those to avoid flu and any other similar respiratory infections. You should maintain good hand, respiratory and personal hygiene, and:

- wash your hands often with warm water and soap
- use tissues to trap germs when you cough or sneeze
- bin used tissues as quickly as possible

We have asked centre, property and regional managers to ensure that posters are placed in each building, and to ensure that supplies of soap are regularly checked and replenished.
